How it All Began

Dawn Dubsky was diagnosed with the most deadly strand of malaria, *Plasmodium falciparum* after returning from a trip to Ghana Africa in 2008. While in the ICU Dawn developed further complications from septic shock, had limited circulation to her extremities, and as a result underwent surgery requiring amputation of her limbs just below the elbows and knees. Dawn realized she was a quadruple amputee approximately one month later when she came back to consciousness, and felt extremely devastated about her limb loss.
